


- (v) To enter into any agreement with the government or any other person or persons(s) for receiving grant for the society.
- (vi) To raise and borrow money on bonds, promisory notes or any other obligations on securities founded or based upon all or any of the properties or assets of the Society without any securities or upon such temrs and conditions as the Executive Committee may think fit.
- (vii) To invest the funds of the Society as they may deem fit from time to time.
- (viii) To make such grants as they may think fit for the benefit of any employee or employee(s) of the Society.
- (ix) To make such rules and bye-laws as they may, from time to time, consider necessary for regulating the mangement of the Society.
- (x) The Executive Committee shall appoint auditors for such periods on such remunerations as they may think fit.
- (xi) The Executive Committee may of their own motion and on the written requisition of seven members shall call an extraordinary general meeting of the Society. The notice of such meeting and the subjects thereof shall be served on each members of the Society 15 days before the date fixed for the meeting.
- (xii) The Executive Committee shall cause true accounts to be kept of the Society's transaction and of all sums and moneys received and expended by them, and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and the credits and liabilities of the Society. The books of account shall be kept in the office of the Society.

14. Meetings / Quorums, Notices and Agenda of the Executive Committee :-

- (i) The Executive Committee shall meet at least thrice a year.
- (ii) All meetings shall be summoned by the General Secretary / President, who will give seven days notice for such meetings along with the agenda.
- (iii) The quorum of the meeting of the Executive Committee shall be 1/3rd of the total number of members of the Executive Committee.
- (iv) The President or, in his absence, the Vice-President shall preside. In the absence of both, the members present shall elect one of themselves to preside. The person presiding over the meeting shall have a casting vote.
- (v) The records of the meeting of the Executive Committee shall be kept by the General Secretary & signed by the person presiding at the next meeting of the Society.
